Report of Officers:

MAYOR'S REPORT: Pro Tempore McFerron read Mayors Court Report and Mayors Report. McFerron reported the Memorial Day Parade will be on May 30th, line-up begins at 8AM outside of town hall and the parade begins at 9AM.

GRANTS/CONTRACTS: Mrs. McFerron Chairperson, (Ott, Gil) McFerron reported that the Village was rewarded the OPWC pavement road grant (240k) for Galbraith Road, we are waiting to see if we get the additional grant to cover the remaining that the Village is responsible for covering (90K).

FINANCE: Mrs. Davis Chairperson, (McFerron, Ott). Davis read the expenses and balances for the month of April 2022. For April, expenses were \$72,790.24 and receipts were \$66,991.07.

PUBLIC LANDS/HEALTH & WELFARE: Ms. Ott Chairperson, (Davis, McKinney) Ott was present via cellphone but has nothing to report.

ZONING/SPECIAL PROJECTS/HISTORICAL: Mr. Imbus Chairperson (Gil, McFerron) Imbus reported he is still working with the website designer on the Village's new webpage. Imbus inquired about meeting minutes on the website and requested scans or copies of some

older photos for the site.
